


Figure 2: Tan Son Nhat International Airport - Departure floor map




Figure 3: Tan Son Nhat Domestic Airport – Arrival and Departure floor map




Figure 4: Danang International Airport - Arrival floor map




Figure 5: Danang Domestic Airport - Arrival floor map

#### Instruction for arrival at Tan Son Nhat International Airport

Upon completion of your immigration and customs clearance procedure and retrieving your baggage, please:

- 1. Depending on your booking flight, normally there will be one airport ground staff with your name tag standing right at the airplane exiting gate (before passing custom checkpoint) to instruct your connected flight.
- 2. After passing custome checkpoint, head to baggage claim if you baggage is not directly transferred to ending destination. Then go out of the main lobby, turn right, follow the walking way (red arrow in Fingure 1) to Tan Son Nhat Domestic Airport (about 10 minutes walking).
- 3. Please enter the departure gate of VietnamAirline (red arrow in Figure 3) to check in for domestic flight.

## Instruction for arrival at Danang International or Danang Domestic Airport

Upon completion of your immigration (if directly fly to Danang International Airport) and custom clearance procedure and retrieving your baggage, please:

- 1. Go out of the Main lobby (there is only one exiting gate).
- 2. DUT representatives (their names and positions are described in item 3. of this Guidebook) carrying the name tag "AUN-QA, UD-DUT" with your name written on it. The contact phone numbers of DUT representative are +84 905559266; +84 772278159.
- 3. Upon arrival, AUN-QA Delegation will be transferred to Novotel Hotel by a UD-DUT car.
- 4. Transportation during the assessment will be provided by UD-DUT. Transportation to the airport for departure, for city sightseeing tour will also be arranged by UD-DUT.






## 6. Danang City Tour

## 6.1. Dragon bridge

One of Da Nang's more unusual and unexpected attractions is a bridge in the likeness of a dragon spanning the River Han. If the golden dragon slithering across the water isn't impressive enough, on weekend evenings its body is illuminated by 2,500 LED lights and its head spouts fire and water over the river's eastern bank.

Opened in 2013, the Dragon Bridge carries a six-lane roadway and two sidewalks over the river. The bridge measures 2,000 feet (610 meters) long and 123 feet (37.5 meters) wide. As the shortest road link between the Da Nang International Airport and the bulk of Da Nang city, visitors arriving or departing by air often pass over this bridge.

#### 6.2. Linh Ung Pagoda

Famous for its giant statue of Guanyin, the Buddhist Goddess of Mercy, Linh Ung Pagoda occupies 30 acres (12 hectares) on a hill on the Son Tra Peninsula. Opened in 2010, the relatively new pagoda complex features a mix of modern and traditional Vietnamese temple architecture, including a typical three-entrance gate.

According to local legend, a smaller pagoda was built on the same site during the nineteenth century, when a local villager living on the peninsula found a statue of the Buddha drifting near the beach.

As visitors pass through the main gate of the pagoda, they are met by 18 stone statues of the 18 Arhats, believed to be the original followers of the Buddha, whose expressions run the gamut from joy and love to anger and sadness. Towering above the grounds is the 220-foot (67-meter) Guanyin statue. Within the giant monument, visitors can ascend 17 floors, each displaying Buddha statues depicting his various aspects.

## 6.3. Museum of Cham Sculpture

An open-air colonial building in Da Nang is home to the largest collection of Cham carvings in the world. The Da Nang Museum of Cham Sculpture opened its first gallery in 1919, and in the decades since, the collection has grown to include more than 300 pieces. Many of these terra cotta, sandstone and bronze sculptures and artifacts depict Hindu deities, as well as linga and yoni.

Among the museum's most important items are the sandstone pieces — statues of gods and animals, pedestals and other decorative items taken from Cham temples. The museum also has an exhibit on modern Cham culture, which includes photographs, clothing and film clips.

#### 6.4. Hoi An ancient town

Hoi An Ancient town is located in Viet Nam's central Quang Nam Province, on the north bank near the mouth of the Thu Bon River. The inscribed property comprises 30 ha and it has a buffer zone of 280 ha. It is an exceptionally well-preserved example of a small-scale trading port active the 15th to 19th centuries which traded widely, both with the countries of Southeast and East Asia and with the rest of the world. Its decline in the later 19th century ensured that it has retained its traditional urban tissue to a remarkable degree. The town reflects a fusion of indigenous and foreign cultures (principally Chinese and Japanese with later European influences) that combined to produce this unique survival.

## 7. Exchange Rate

Foreign currencies are not accepted in most shops, so it is best for you to change your foreign currency to the local currency, which is Vietnamese Dong (VND). The current foreign exchange rate (October 2018) is approximately US \$ 1.00 = VND 23,000. These rates are subject to market fluctuations so please check them again prior to your departure date. If you come to Vietnam with some foreign cash, you can exchange it for VND upon arrival at the international airport, banks or currency exchange establishments. You may need to show a passport for identification or fill out a form first. Also please note that many exchange places will not accept old or torn bills. Bring new and crisp bills in order to get the best exchange rate. If you happen to have damaged bills that no one else will accept, simply go to a bank and exchange it for a new note for a nominal fee. Credit cards are accepted by hotels and some shop, however cash is also necessary. There are now a number of ATMs accepting international cards. Please note that most ATMs charge a fee of approximately US\$ 4 for use of international cards. For currency rate please check the link: https://currency-converter.net/

#### 8. Climate

Danang weather in October, 2018, at the time of assessment would be warm and rainy, temperature from 23-32°C.

Electricity used in Vietnam is 220V-50Hz. The types of plug are A and C (as picture below)
